### **Singapore Energy Lecture**

Mr Iswaran, Minister, Prime Minister's Office, Second Minister for Home Affairs and Trade & Industry, spoke on Singapore's strategy to address Singapore's energy challenge. The key thrusts of this strategy are (a) diversification to ensure secure and competitively priced energy supplies, (b) managing energy demand and, (c) encouraging innovation and the development of technology. As part of this strategy, the Singapore Government is proactively seeking innovative energy solutions by exploring options such as electricity import, expanding the electric vehicles test-bed project and setting up a micro-grid test-bed project on Pulau Ubin. The test bed and micro grid projects are also a testament to the Government's continued commitment towards investing in energy R&D and grow the energy industry. These projects will also strengthen Singapore's value proposition as a "living lab" for innovative energy solutions in Asia.
